The Hong Kong Inter-School Choral Festival (HKICF) is organised by The Hong Kong Virtuoso Chorus (HKVC), a registered S.88 charitable organisation. It is dedicated to providing equal access to choral education and fostering a vibrant inter-school choral culture in Hong Kong. HKICF is now the city's largest choral event, engaging over 30,000 participants annually through more than a dozen diverse programmes.
